

PRIVACY POLICY

UPDATED: September 2026

This Privacy Policy explains how Quantum Montessori® collects, uses, stores, and shares personal information through its websites, enrollment process, educational programs, student and family accounts, communications, and related services.

1. Information We Collect

The information we collect depends on how you interact with Quantum Montessori. It may include:

- Website and inquiry information, such as name, email address, telephone number, messages, form submissions, device information, IP address, browser information, and website activity.
- Parent/Home Guide and family information, such as contact details, enrollment selections, communications, billing information, and information needed to administer the family relationship.
- Student information, such as name, age or date of birth, grade level, enrollment information, school account information, attendance, coursework, assignments, grades, assessments, progress information, educational records, portfolio materials, communications, and other information needed to provide the selected educational program.
- Information voluntarily provided by families about a student's learning needs, accommodations, educational history, or other information relevant to educational planning and support.
- Payment and transaction information. Payment-card or banking information may be processed by third-party payment providers; Quantum Montessori may receive transaction, invoice, payment-status, and related account information.
- Photographs, video, audio, or other multimedia when submitted, created, or used in connection with School programs, subject to applicable consent and opt-out provisions.
- Applicant, contractor, or employment information when a person applies to work with or provide services to Quantum Montessori.

2. How We Collect Information

Information may be collected directly from you or your student; through website forms, enrollment forms, School accounts, classes, assignments, assessments, communications, and support requests; automatically through website technologies; from authorized third-party funding or educational partners; and from service providers used to operate School programs.

3. How We Use Information

- respond to inquiries and communicate with prospective and enrolled families;
- process enrollment, administer accounts, invoices, payments, and third-party funding arrangements;
- provide curriculum, instruction, work plans, academic support, assessments, grading, progress monitoring, attendance tracking, records, transcripts, portfolios, and other services appropriate to the selected program;
- create and manage student and Home Guide accounts and provide access to learning and administrative systems;
- communicate about classes, schedules, School operations, student progress, account matters, security, and policy changes;
- maintain educational, administrative, financial, and business records;
- protect the security, integrity, rights, safety, and property of students, families, staff, Quantum Montessori, and others;

- comply with applicable law, legal process, contractual obligations, and legitimate School recordkeeping requirements;
- improve School programs, services, technology, and website functionality; and
- use multimedia for School marketing or promotional purposes when authorized under the applicable enrollment consent and opt-out terms.

4. Student and Education Information

Quantum Montessori recognizes that student and educational information requires particular care. Student information is used and disclosed for legitimate educational, administrative, safety, recordkeeping, and operational purposes and in accordance with applicable law and School policy.

The Student & Family Handbook states the School's commitment to the confidentiality and security of student records and to the applicable rights of Home Guides and eligible students regarding education records. Requests concerning official student records may be directed to records@qmontessori.org.

5. Children and Parental Involvement

Quantum Montessori provides educational services to children, so this Privacy Policy does not state that we never collect information from children. Student information may be collected as reasonably necessary to provide an enrolled student's educational program, accounts, coursework, communication, assessment, records, and support.

Enrollment and educational services for minors are authorized by a parent or legal guardian as required by the applicable enrollment process. We do not knowingly use student information for unrelated commercial purposes in a manner inconsistent with this Policy, School agreements, or applicable law.

6. Educational and Operational Service Providers

Quantum Montessori uses third-party providers to support educational and business operations. Depending on the program and services in use, these may include learning-management systems, student-information systems, Google-based School accounts or sites, video-conferencing tools, assessment and adaptive-learning platforms, transcript services, payment processors, communications providers, curriculum providers, hosting providers, and other technology or professional services.

These providers may process information on Quantum Montessori's behalf or under their own applicable terms and privacy policies. We share information with providers only as reasonably necessary for the relevant service, contractual relationship, or lawful purpose.

7. When Information May Be Shared

Quantum Montessori does not disclose personal information indiscriminately. Information may be shared:

- with service providers and contractors that support School operations and educational services;
- with educational, dual-enrollment, transcript, assessment, or partner organizations when necessary for a service requested or authorized by the family;
- with ESA, scholarship, voucher, grant, school-choice, payment, or other funding entities as necessary to administer funding or payment arrangements;
- with a parent, legal guardian, eligible student, or other authorized person as appropriate;
- when required by law, subpoena, court order, legal process, or governmental request;
- when reasonably necessary to protect safety, prevent fraud or misuse, secure systems, enforce agreements, or protect legal rights; or
- with another entity in connection with a merger, reorganization, financing, sale, or transfer of all or part of the applicable business, subject to appropriate legal protections.

8. Marketing Communications

We may send communications about Quantum Montessori programs, events, resources, or services to persons who have requested information or otherwise provided appropriate contact information. Marketing communications may be unsubscribed from using the method provided in the communication.

Administrative, enrollment, billing, safety, security, and other non-marketing communications may still be sent when necessary.

9. Cookies and Website Technologies

Our websites may use cookies and similar technologies for essential functionality, forms, preferences, security, analytics, and third-party integrations. Additional information is provided in the Quantum Montessori Cookie Policy.

10. Data Retention

We retain information for as long as reasonably necessary for the purpose for which it was collected and to satisfy educational recordkeeping, contractual, financial, legal, security, and operational requirements. Different categories of information may be retained for different periods.

11. Security

Quantum Montessori uses reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational measures intended to protect personal information. No website, internet transmission, electronic storage system, or third-party platform can be guaranteed to be completely secure.

12. Access, Correction, and Privacy Requests

Parents/Home Guides and eligible students may request access to or correction of applicable student records consistent with School policy and applicable law. Other individuals may contact us to request access, correction, deletion, or other action concerning personal information where such rights apply. We may need to verify identity and may retain information when required or permitted by law, contract, educational recordkeeping obligations, or legitimate business requirements.

13. Third-Party Websites

Our websites and educational services may link to or integrate with third-party websites and platforms. Quantum Montessori does not control the independent privacy practices of third parties. Families and users should review the privacy terms applicable to those services.

14. International Users

Quantum Montessori is based in the United States. Information submitted from outside the United States may be processed or stored in the United States or other locations used by our service providers. International users are responsible for understanding any local requirements applicable to their use of the services, and Quantum Montessori will honor applicable privacy rights where legally required.

15. Changes to This Privacy Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy to reflect changes in our services, technology, legal obligations, or privacy practices. The current version will be identified by its update date.
